Day 1: Saturday, October 9, 2027 Overnight Flight
Breathtaking Alpine vistas await as you travel through Italy and Switzerland. Experience dramatic views aboard railways and lake cruises while enjoying cultural experiences in charming villages.

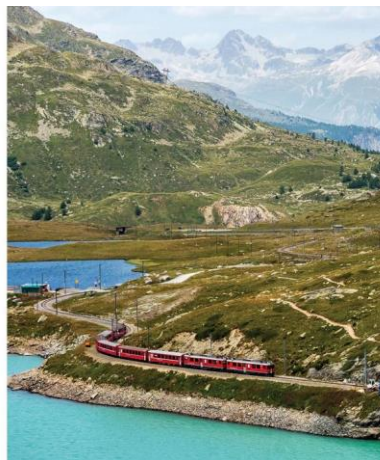
Day 2: Sunday, October 10, 2027 Lake Maggiore, Italy
Welcome to the serene region of Lake Maggiore, where crystal clear waters meet the dramatic backdrop of the Alps. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the lakeside at your own pace. As the evening approaches, board a private boat bound for the charming island of Isola Dei Pescatori.* Gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner and toast the start of the journey. (D)

Day 3: Monday, October 11, 2027 Lake Maggiore This morning, set sail to *Isola Bella*, known as the “beautiful island.” With an expert guide, explore the magnificent Borromeo Palace, a lakeside Baroque masterpiece surrounded by ornate gardens. Return to shore at around noon, and the remainder of the day is yours to explore at leisure. Perhaps you’ll take time to stroll the cobbled streets of Stresa or soak up the sun along the waterfront. (B)

Day 4: Tuesday, October 12, 2027 Lake Maggiore - Val d'Ossola - Zermatt, Switzerland Depart Italy and travel towards Switzerland. Along the way, visit a family-owned dairy farm in Val d'Ossola, where you'll meet the owners and learn about traditional Alpine farming. Enjoy a rustic lunch featuring homemade regional specialties. Continue your journey through the historic Simplon Pass, once used by traders and even Napoleon to cross the Alps. By day's end, arrive in the car-free mountain village of Zermatt, nestled beneath the iconic Matterhorn. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Wednesday, October 13, 2027 Zermatt Start the day with a guided walk led by your Tour Manager to become familiar with the charming village of Zermatt. The remainder of the day is yours to explore independently. Perhaps visit the Matterhorn Museum** to uncover the area's mountaineering history or ride the Gornergrat Railway*** for sweeping views of the Matterhorn and surrounding peaks. (B)

Day 6: Thursday, October 14, 2027 Zermatt - St. Moritz Today, board the legendary Glacier Express train.**** This world-famous scenic railway carries you across some of Switzerland's most dramatic landscapes, passing snow-capped peaks, deep valleys, dense forests, and rushing streams. Arrive in St. Moritz, where the afternoon is yours to relax or stroll along the lakeside promenade. (B, L)

Day 7: Friday, October 15, 2027 St. Moritz - Le Prese -

St. Moritz Embark on an unforgettable rail journey aboard the Bernina Express,**** traveling from St. Moritz to Tirano and marveling at breathtaking Alpine views, including the impressive Morteratsch Glacier. Explore Tirano's historic streets, seamlessly blending charm with mountain splendor. Continue by coach to Le Prese, a lakeside village known for its peaceful setting on Lake Poschiavo offering scenic mountain views. Enjoy a delicious lunch featuring farm-grown ingredients at a family-owned herb farm set on the sunny slopes of Val Poschiavo. Later, join local guide and learn about the cultivation and processing of organic herbs at the farm fields. Upon return to St. Moritz, the evening is yours to explore on own. (B, L)

Day 8: Saturday, October 16, 2027 St. Moritz - Lucerne

Travel to Lucerne, widely regarded as one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities. En route, stop at the Lion Monument, carved into sandstone to honor the Swiss Guards who died during the French Revolution. The "Swiss Paradise on the Lake," nestled among breathtaking mountains and a picturesque lake, is

yours to explore. Enjoy an evening at leisure, or perhaps join an optional evening cruise on Lake Lucerne. (B)

Day 9: Sunday, October 17, 2027 Lucerne

This morning, join a local guide for a walking tour through Lucerne's charming *Altstadt* (Old Town). Cross the iconic Chapel Bridge and see the historic Water Tower that once served as a prison. Then, **it's your choice!** Choose to take a short funicular ride to exciting views over Lucerne and the lake from the famous Gütsch viewpoint **-OR-** connect with Lucerne's natural and cultural heritage at the engaging Museum Lucerne. Later, ascend Mount Pilatus***** via panoramic gondola and the world's steepest cogwheel railway. At the summit, enjoy spectacular views from more than 7,000 feet above sea level before descending by gondola. Tonight, gather for a farewell dinner featuring traditional Swiss specialties. (B, D)

Day 10: Monday, October 18, 2027 Lucerne - Tour Ends

Your scenic journey comes to an end today in Lucerne. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

The tour makes use of several trains for transfers; travelers must be able to climb on/off trains with carry-on bags and maneuver through crowded stations and platforms.

Most walking tours involve cobblestone streets, uneven village pathways, and moderate hills. Some activities involve boarding boats.

Boarding and disembarking the boats may require stepping on and off a moving vessel, sometimes with small gaps between the dock and a boat which requires agility. Surfaces can be slightly uneven and slippery, especially in wet conditions.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Weather in the Alps can change quickly, especially when traveling between lake regions and higher mountain elevations. From spring through autumn, you may experience warm sunshine in the valleys and cooler temperatures in the mountains on the same day. Spring and autumn tend to bring cooler morning and evenings, while summer days are usually mild to warm. At higher elevations, such as during mountain excursions or scenic train journeys, temperatures can be significantly cooler than in the towns below.

On this tour, you will experience a range of elevations, from lakeside towns to higher Alpine viewpoints. Most overnight locations such as Lake Maggiore, Zermatt, St. Moritz and Lucerne sit at moderate elevation.

The highest elevation on this tour will be at Mount Pilatus, approximately 6,800 feet/2,073 meters. This reflects the highest point visited and does not include the summit of the mountain.

On the days you travel to a new city to overnight, you will likely have an early morning start time and evening arrival due to the distances traveled and stops along the way.

The Glacier Express runs between Zermatt and St. Moritz. Beginning to end, it is an 8-hour journey.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

*In the event of adverse weather conditions, dinner on Pescatori Island may be relocated to your hotel.

****On some departures, the cogwheel train to Mount Pilatus may be unavailable, and both the ascent and descent will be by panorama gondolas and aerial cableway.

****Group space on the Glacier Express and Bernina Express may be limited. As a result, alternative transportation may be utilized. In such instances, travelers will be notified in advance and offered compensation.

The Bernina Express operates on a scheduled route from St. Moritz to Tirano from May 2nd through October 15th. For tour dates outside of this period, an alternative schedule or regional train service will be provided.

**If you wish to visit the Matterhorn Museum, tickets can be purchased directly at the museum entrance or through the Zermatt tourism website.

Plan to spend about 45-60 minutes exploring the exhibits. The museum is an easy walk from your hotel.

***The scenic cogwheel train departs from the Gornergrat station next to Zermatt's main train station. The ride takes about 30-33 minutes each way. Tickets can be purchased online in advance, or at the railway ticket counter at the station. Bring a warm layer or jacket, as temperatures at higher elevations can be significantly cooler than in the village.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Zacchera Hotels is a hotel chain in Lake Maggiore. The exact hotel to be used will be available 15 days prior to the tour departure date.

Many hotels in Switzerland do not offer air conditioning and availability of fans may be limited or not available.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple rooms are not available.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our departure transfers will leave from Lucerne for Zurich airport.

Our air travelers will arrive into Milan, Italy airport and depart from Zurich, Switzerland airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel.
