## ITINERARY

### Day 1 – Wednesday, June 2

This is your chance to experience the charm and character of iconic coastal destinations—from the gingerbread cottages of Martha's Vineyard to the cobblestone streets of Nantucket. With beautiful vistas, rich history, and unforgettable experiences at every stop, this is a coastal getaway you won't want to miss and where every day brings something new to explore! Depart from your hometown and travel to Cape Cod with meal and comfort stops along the way. After checking in, enjoy an included buffet dinner at the hotel. Relax and refresh this evening on your own.

### Day 2 – Thursday, June 3

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, board the coach and continue to **Martha's Vineyard** via ferry (1 hour). Enjoy a **"Down Island" walking tour** and learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders as you pass through the picturesque villages. The group will stroll through **"Cottage City"** that features the Flying Horses Carousel, the Tabernacle, Union Chapel, Back Door Donuts and more (total walk is about 1 mile). After your tour, enjoy lunch in the historic whaling town of **Edgartown** with plenty of time for a meal and window-shopping. Following your free time, the group will take the ferry back to the mainland for a relaxing evening with dinner at Yarmouth House, a family-owned fine dining establishment focused on steak and seafood. After dinner return to the hotel for the evening.

### Day 3 – Friday, June 4

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning before meeting your Step-On Guide. Travel historic **Route 6A, the Old King's Highway**, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history, past hundreds of structures which characterize its early development. See the **Cape Cod National Seashore**, 40 miles of pristine sandy beaches that support diverse species, and the **Eastham Windmill**, believed to be the oldest and last working gristmill on Cape Cod. Time-permitting, stop for a photo-op at **Nauset Lighthouse**, also known as **Cape Cod Lighthouse**. Arrive at Province Lands Visitor's Center and enjoy a 360-degree view of the **Province dunes, the Outer Beach and the Atlantic Ocean** from the observation deck! Learn about local flora and fauna through the exhibits or shop for souvenirs in the Center's bookstore.

After your visit, you'll experience a 1-hour dune tour that allows visitors to explore the sand dunes of Cape Cod National Seashore and view the remains of the **Peaked Hill Lifesaving Station**. Tour takes place from enclosed 7- or 9-passenger vehicles. Following your dune tour, enjoy lunch on your own in Provincetown before departing on a **Whale Watching cruise** (4 hours). This evening, enjoy dinner included before returning to the hotel.

### Day 4 – Saturday, June 5

Following breakfast at the hotel, embark on the ferry to Nantucket! Here, friendly island tour guides take you away from downtown and allow you to enjoy the natural beauty Nantucket has to offer. The tour features the Old Mill, Sconset Village, Sankaty Head Lighthouse and much more (1 hour, 15 min)! This afternoon, return to downtown to enjoy lunch on your own and free time to explore the quaint boutique and pristine beaches. Return to mainland via ferry for a waterfront dinner overlooking Parker's River. After, return to your hotel for the evening.

### Day 5 – Sunday, June 6

This morning, enjoy breakfast before checking out of the hotel. Travel to the John F. Kennedy Hyannis Museum featuring a thematic panorama of photos, archival films, artifacts, text panels and oral histories of JFK and his family. Then, depart for Sandwich, the village with views of Shawmer Pond and historic Dexter Grist Mill. Enjoy lunch on your own before departing for the Sandwich Glass Museum. Learn why the Boston & Sandwich Glass Company led the world in the manufacture of glass during the early 19th century before watching a glassblowing demonstration, followed by a Q&A. This evening, dinner will be included at a local restaurant in Mystic, Connecticut, before you proceed to your hotel for check-in.
