ITINERARY

Day 1 – Monday, August 16

Travel in elegant fashion through the heart of America's heritage on a thoughtfully curated journey where history, artistry, and scenic railways converge. Depart from your hometown and travel to Pittsburgh with comfort stops along the way. Arrive this afternoon at Pittsburgh's Station Square for lunch on your own and some time to rest. Following lunch, the group will continue to Duquesne Incline. Take a step back in time on a century-old cable car and see the best views of downtown Pittsburgh while riding one of the few remaining inclines in the country. Depart the Incline to check into your hotel for the evening. For dinner, enjoy the hotel's included Kickback Reception or on your own at one of the many restaurants within walking distance.

Day 2 – Tuesday, August 17

Check out after a light breakfast at the hotel this morning, board the coach and travel to **Farmington, Pennsylvania**. You'll have lunch included at the **Historic Stone House Restaurant & Inn** before continuing to Frank Lloyd Wright's **Fallingwater**. The home was designed for the Kauffman family of Pittsburgh and appears to have grown out of the ground and into the light on the boulder on which it sits above the waterfall. Following a tour of the home, board your coach and depart for your hotel in West Virginia. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Hotel (4 nts): Tygart Hotel, Ascend Hotel Collection (206 Davis Ave, Elkins, WV 26241)

Day 3 – Wednesday, August 18

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning before traveling to **The Greenbrier Resort**, a world-class resort and National Historic Landmark set among West Virginia's majestic **Allegheny Mountains**. Upon arrival, you'll have time on your own to explore the resort and grab a bite to eat at one of the restaurants open to the public. Then, meet back with your Host to check in for your **Bunker Tour**. In 1958, Congress instructed The Greenbrier to build the **West Virginia Wing** to conceal the construction of an emergency Cold War fallout shelter and relocation facility for Congress. Once veiled in secrecy, The Greenbrier Bunker stands today as a captivating historical landmark, inviting guests to embark on an unforgettable 90-minute journey through its corridors and chambers. After, board the motor coach and return to your hotel for the evening, stopping at **Graceland Inn & Henry's Restaurant** for dinner included.

Day 4 – Thursday, August 19

Following breakfast at the hotel, depart to explore the West Virginia Railroad Museum, located in the historic Darden Mills. After a short tour, depart for **Mountain Rail West Virginia** and board the **New Tygart Flyer**. This wilderness excursion features mountain grades, an "S" curve tunnel, a high bridge and miles of unspoiled mountain views. Vintage diesel-powered locomotives climb along the **cascading Shavers Fork of the Cheat River to the High Falls of Cheat**. Enjoy the view relaxing aboard their comfortable climate-controlled passenger coaches. Lunch is included on board. After your train ride, return to the hotel to relax and refresh before dinner and a show this evening at the Railyard Event and Conference Center.

Day 5 – Friday, August 20

Breakfast will be at the hotel this morning, before the group travels to Cass for a ride on the **Cass Scenic Railroad!** The trip to Whittaker Station takes two hours for the eight-mile round trip. Passing the water tower and machine shop, the railroad begins to climb lower slopes of **Cheat Mountain** along picturesque **Leatherbark Creek**. The train then zigzags through two switchbacks, the engines alternately pushing then pulling passenger cars because the grade is so steep. After passing the entrance to **Cass Cave**, the railroad levels off for the stop at **Whittaker Station**, surrounded by green meadows and fine views of the countryside. There is a cool, shady grove with tables where excursionists may rest and enjoy the scenery. Lunch will be on your own at **Shay's Restaurant** when you return to the station in Cass. Following your excursion, visit the **Green Bank Telescope** and tour the **National Radio Astronomy Observatory**. Intentionally located in one of America's quietest spots, here our scientists are listening to sounds from space. Return to Elkins this evening for dinner included at **C.J. Maggie's**.

Day 6 – Saturday, August 21

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out and traveling to **Old Town Winchester** for free time and lunch on your own at the walking mall. After, continue home with wonderful memories of Pittsburgh and West Virginia.
